Call to Action

Support Healthy School Nutrition & Physical Activity Environments!

SB65 (Torlakson)	Requires schools to provide parents with written notification and an opportunity comment on non-exclusive soda contracts. We expect the bill to be amended to include junk food contracts, too.
SB70 (Torlakson)	Requires California Department of Education to include physical fitness program guidelines as part of technical assistance to after school programs. We anticipate the bill will be amended to include nutrition information.
SB677 (Ortiz)	Bans sodas from elementary, middle schools and high schools ½ hour before school starts to ½ hour after the school day ends. Also sets nutrition standards and portion sizes for other beverages sold at school.
AB598 (Hancock)	Requires all buildings modernized through the use of Leroy F. Greene School Facilities Act funds to include functional water fountains. Schools applying to use Leroy F. Greene funds solely for water fountain modernization would not have to meet standard building age requirements. Schools would also be allowed to use Leroy F. Greene funds for water fountain modernization even if they had accessed this fund for a previous modernization project.

Support Community Nutrition Improvements!

SB74 (Torlakson, Escutia, Ortiz)	At least 50% of food sold in vending machines found on state property must be from a healthy list of foods. State property includes road stops, state parks, state office buildings (CalTrans, DMV, Veterans Affairs) and state monuments.
